

Internet Safety Workshop

Audience: KS3 (Year 7 & Year 8)

Time: 45 minutes

Capacity: Up to 50 pupils



Learning Outcomes

- To understand what is meant by 'social media';
- To explore the key risks when online and when using social media;
- To be able to keep safe online and seek advice and support when needed.

Our Internet Safety workshop aims to provide pupils with the skills they need to stay safe online, with a focus on using social media, online gaming and the potential dangers associated with grooming and sexting.

Pupils will be asked to sit in our 360 Room, and will be asked about what social media is, and what examples of social media apps and websites they have heard of, or that they may be using.

Afterwards, three examples will be projected on to the walls which depict:

- A social media page
- An online argument between two people
- A private chat between two strangers

Children will be given 5-10 minutes to walk around the room and think about all of the potential risks and issues illustrated in each of the examples, before feeding back as a group, and discussing each issue, including grooming and sexting.



Did you know?

Around 1 in 7 young people have taken a semi-naked or naked picture of themselves. Over half went on to share the picture with someone else.
